Day-By-Day Itinerary

Day 1: April 26: Leave the USA on your overnight flight to Italy.

Day 2: April 27: Puglia Lecce: Arrive at Brindisi airport. Upon arrival, proceed to the baggage claim and after clearing customs, you will be met by local Tours Tour Manager. Welcome to Puglia one of Italy's hidden treasures. This is the region of fine weather, beautiful shorelines, lovely towns, baroque architecture and delicious cuisine. You will be transferred to our beautiful hotel in the city center of Lecce. We will see with its wealth of art, elegance, and culture, why Lecce is called the "Florence of the South". Enjoy some time for a little rest. Later in the afternoon, a special appointment awaits us as we reach an historical palace in central Lecce. The owner will welcome you and share interesting stories and anecdotes about his family and the palazzo. You will also visit the small museum which hosts a rich collection of ancient objects, pieces of furniture and dresses that belonged to the ancestors of the owner. Enjoy an aperitif at Palazzo made of local dishes and drinks. (Breakfast, Aperitif with local snacks)

Day 3: April 28: Lecce: Enjoy breakfast at the Hotel. Then depart for a walking tour of the historical center of Lecce with our local guide. We will see beautiful Baroque style monuments featuring a wealth of embellishment and decorations to appear embroidered. Visit the Basilica di Santa Croce, site of the most important local Roman ruins, the Duomo, standing in one of the loveliest piazzas of Italy and the Roman amphitheater dating back to the 2nd century. Spend the rest of the day at leisure to discover Lecce on our own, and try some of the local restaurants serving traditional Pugliese food. (Breakfast)

Day 4: April 29: Otranto / Santa Maria di Leuca / Lecce: After breakfast we depart for our tour of the southern part of the region. Our destination is Otranto, the easternmost Italian town, a beautiful ancient village along the coast. Enjoy the unforgettable views of this nice coastline and take in the breeze coming from the blue Adriatic Sea. Once in Otranto, stroll along the narrow streets and see the Aragonese Castle and its harbor. Visit the unique Cathedral with the splendid imposing mosaic. We reach a local farmhouse for lunch with delicious regional dishes. After lunch, set out on a picturesque drive that will take you to Santa Maria di Leuca, located at the very end of the tip of Italian heel where the Adriatic Sea meets the Ionian Sea. Rocky coastline, beaches, fishing villages and watchtowers characterize this charming area. The fresh air and the sea breeze you will enjoy here will be memory for lifetime! (Breakfast, Lunch)

Day 5: April 30: Manduria / Alberobello: After breakfast, check out from the hotel and depart for north Puglia, our home for the next 4 days. We will make a short deviation for a journey out into the countryside to reach Manduria the wine district producer of the prestigious Primitivo wine. Visit the local winery which houses an interesting museum of local traditions, a fascinating journey through time. The Museum of the Wine Primitivo is housed in the Winery, created as a remembrance of the men and the objects that marked the history of producing the Primitivo wine. A fascinating journey through time, into more than thirty settings in ancient underground cisterns of a nineteenth-century cellar, all transformed into original environments depicting life in past years. After the visit, you will enjoy wine tastings paired with authentic rural food/gastronomy. After lunch, depart for a scenic drive crossing the Trulli Valley and Alberobello, a UNESCO World Heritage Site famous for its stunning collection of unique houses with conical roofs. A trullo is a small dwelling built from the local limestone, with dry-stone walls and a characteristic conical roof. It is a traditional and simple type of structure which you'll see dotted around this part of Puglia, sometimes in its most basic form used as a shed among the olive groves. Enjoy a nice walk in Alberobello to discover the Trulli village. The principal tourist activity in Alberobello is wandering around looking at trulli. There are also a handful of small museums and plenty of opportunities for buying souvenirs and tasting local products. Check in at our Hotel in Alberobello or Bari area. Dinner at leisure (Breakfast, Lunch)

Day 6: May 1: Ostuni / Martina Franca: After breakfast we depart for our daily activity. We reach a fortified Masseria, an active olive oil farm boasting massive centuries old olive trees, still producing a supreme quality extra virgin oil. Visit the farm and the amazing underground olive mill which dates back to Roman times. Try some delicious extra virgin olive oil guided by the owner who will accompany your tasting with his anecdotes. Later, we reach Ostuni, known as the white capital and one of the most stunning towns of Southern Italy. Ostuni village clings onto three hills at the edge of Le Murge. The old center is a spiral of whitewashed houses with dramatic views of a sea of olive trees and further away, the blue Mediterranean Sea. After, make a stop in Martina Franca, a little baroque jewel built like a balcony overlooking the land of Trulli. We will take a short walk in Martina Franca before reaching our local butcher a paradise for meat lovers have dinner at Braceria where the butcher will grill exquisite meat dishes. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 7: May 2: Matera: After breakfast day at leisure. We depart for Matera, home to cave dwellings called the "Sassi", declared a UNESCO Heritage in 1993 and now one of Italy's most fascinating icons. For millennia, people of this area have carved dwellings directly into ravines and gullies made of tufa, a characteristic honey-colored soft stone. Today the area still evokes ancient times, providing the backdrop for Mel Gibson's film, "Passion of the Christ" which was filmed here. The guided tour is developed through a complex and unique location within the characteristic districts of Sassi. Visit a rupestrian Church cut into the rock of hillsides and ravines, created in the during the eighth and ninth centuries by Basilian monks who were fleeing the iconoclastic persecution of the Byzantine Empire. The cave contains faded frescoes in the Byzantine style. We will also explore a Cave House, a fascinating opportunity to see the typical layout of an inhabited cave, as they would have been until being deserted in the 1950s. After lunch at local restaurant, enjoy some free time for personal discovery. Return to Hotel. (Breakfast, Lunch)

Day 8: May 3: Trani & Farewell Lunch at Farm: After breakfast, meet your guide and driver and depart for the pretty fishing town of Trani. Walk the streets of Trani, often called the pearl of the Adriatic Sea, a city known for its 19th century architecture and medieval art. See the castle and continue to the magnificent Cathedral which stands towering over the sea and is one of the most beautiful and evocative Romanesque-style cathedrals in Apulia. Proceed to visit an authentic Masseria located into the Murgia National park. The family-run farm produces some great dairy products. Learn from "Grandpa" how the family grew up and learned the secrets of their production. Have a delicious farewell lunch with farm products and dishes of ancient recipes. Evening at leisure (Breakfast, Lunch)

Day 9: May 4: Italy / USA: After breakfast transfer to the airport (Bari) for return flight to USA. Arrivederci Italia!

SICILY EXTENSION – 4 nights

Day 9: May 4: PALERMO

Enjoy breakfast at the Hotel. Transfer to Bari airport for your short flight to Sicily. After arrival at PMO airport, meet your tour guide and transfer to your hotel in central Palermo, Sicily's capital who owes its name to its location on the sea. It prospered under the Romans, but its high point in art and culture was under the Arabs. Later, when the Normans invaded Sicily, it became the capital of their kingdom. Architecturally, Palermo flourished in the 17th and 18th centuries and its Baroque buildings evoke this period. After check in at your hotel and some time for resting, meet your local guide for a guided tour of Palermo city center, where you will explore old avenues and Arabic neighborhoods, iconic cathedrals, Teatro Massimo, Palermo's elegant Opera House (from outside). Your guided tour will include also a visit of the Palatine Chapel located inside the Norman Palace and the magnificent Cathedral. Enjoy a "welcome to Sicily" dinner at local restaurant savoring traditional Sicilian cuisine. (Dinner)

Day 10: May 5: CEFALU'

Enjoy a relaxing breakfast at your hotel this morning, followed by some time at leisure to relax by the pool or do some shopping in town. Early in the afternoon, we depart with your tour manager to visit Cefalù. Cefalù was founded on a hillside facing the sea near Palermo. It retains its medieval appearance with the center of the town located around a Norman cathedral which was built by Roger II in the 12th century. The homes in town have interesting architectural details and the many shops offer an array of local crafts. There is also a long beach with fine sand right in town. Enjoy dinner at local restaurant facing the blue sea. Return to Palermo for overnight. (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 11: May 6: AGRIGENTO

After breakfast, depart for Agrigento. This morning, our sightseeing tour takes us to the Valley of the Temples ruins, where the city's ancient architects erected most of their sacred buildings during the fifth century BC. The four major temples are absolutely stunning, reflecting the wealth and luxury of ancient Agrigento. The panoramic view of the Valley of the Temples is truly grand, overlooking some of the most impressive Greek ruins of the Mediterranean. The gently rolling hills surrounding the spectacular temples wear a white mantle of blossoms, gleaming on hundreds of almond trees, filling the air with the sweet perfume that heralds the arrival of spring. Return to Palermo for evening at leisure. (Breakfast)

Day 12: May 7: ERICE, SALT ROAD

After breakfast, depart on a full day excursion to the medieval town of Erice, built on the hilltop of Monte San Giuliano. It was an ancient settlement, predating the Middle Ages, but little remains from this period. The town features incredible city walls, fine paved streets, stone houses with decorated doorways, and open spaces with churches, all dating from the Middle Ages. Later, we reach an Oil Mill and Farmhouse, locally called "Baglio Fontanasalsa", to experience true Sicilian traditions and have a country style lunch with simple and delicious Sicilian products which knowledge has been passed from generation to generation. Early in the afternoon, drive along salt pans and Sicilian windmills, where you will see numerous dazzlingly white mountains shimmering in the sun. These are not snow-capped mountains but hills of salt, an unreal scenario created by the salt flats, which form a sort of immense chessboard that ranges in color from off-green to pink. Return to Palermo in the evening. (Breakfast, Lunch)

Day 13: May 8: Italy / USA: After breakfast transfer to the airport for return flight to USA. Arrivederci Italia!
