## **Dr. Angélica Ramsey Is Lone Finalist for FWISD Superintendent**

*Final Board Action Expected in September*

**Dr. Angélica Ramsey** is the lone finalist for the position of Superintendent of the Fort Worth ISD.

District trustees voted unanimously on the action in a special board meeting Tuesday night. In Texas, a 21-day waiting period will now begin, with final action expected to take place at a board meeting in September.

Dr. Ramsey currently serves as superintendent of Midland ISD. Prior to her time MISD, she spent almost five years as superintendent of schools at the Pleasant Valley School District in California. Originally, she lived and worked in the community of Socorro ISD for more than a decade.

“We are excited to name Dr. Angélica Ramsey as the lone finalist for superintendent of the Fort Worth ISD,” said **Board President Tobi Jackson**. “She will bring her many amazing leadership qualities to our District and to the benefit of our greater community”

Dr. Ramsey describes herself as an inclusive and deliberative CEO who places students first and is results oriented. She says she makes it a point to be visible in classrooms and in the community.

“I am extremely honored to join the Fort Worth ISD team,” said Dr. Ramsey. “I look forward to meeting with our stakeholders, visiting classrooms, and working together to provide a world-class education for all students.”

Dr. Ramsey holds a Bachelor's Degree from the University of the Pacific, a Master's Degree from the University of Texas at El Paso, and a Doctorate in Educational Leadership from Liberty University. Prior to her superintendency, she held positions as an associate superintendent, chief academic officer, high school principal, assistant principal, academy coordinator, classroom teacher, and athletic coach.

She met her husband Daryton while they were in training in the U.S. Army. She is currently very active in the Midland community, serving on the board of directors for several civic organizations and is a member of the Midland Rotary Club.

**Superintendent Kent P. Scribner** announced in January his plans to retire. He came to Fort Worth in the fall of 2015; his last day as superintendent is Wednesday, August 31.
